#### WHAT IS WASC?

WASC is the Western Association for Schools and Colleges, which gives accreditation to all schools.

#### WHAT IS ACCREDITATION?

Accreditation is the recognition that a school has reached a standard for its graduates to attend other schools of higher learning. The goal of accreditation is to ensure that education provided by the school meets acceptable levels of quality.

### WHAT DOES THAT MEAN FOR MANN UCLA CS?

Since we have expanded to include 9<sup>th</sup> grade, WASC must visit our school to ensure that we are providing quality education for all of our students. Our school must reach the standards of WASC to guarantee that all of our graduates can attend colleges and universities.

## WHICH GRADE LEVELS WILL RECEIVE ACCREDITATION?

WASC will award accreditation to ALL grades 6-9. They will also return each year to award accreditation to any additional grades that we add to our school. We are expanding each year to add another grade level, so WASC will return each year to award accreditation to grades 10-12.

#### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Hello Mann UCLA Panthers. This is Principal Johnson wishing everyone well for the 2018 New Year. As we transition to the Spring Semester, we need to focus on the following to ensure our students' success:

- In addition to quality instruction in the classrooms, we have started our online-based intervention. We used Innovation Settlement Funds to purchase the Revolution K12 program which officers students a computer based intervention in math and English. This will help our students achieve the goal of increasing our SBAC scores by at least 5% in English and math.
- We will be recognizing students with 96% attendance or better monthly. Students with a 91% or less attendance rate will receive a letter that will require parents/guardians to meet and discuss various ways to improve attendance. Please encourage our students to attend school everyday. This is especially important during SBAC testing in May 2018.
- We have various initiatives and activities scheduled to help improve our ability to collaborate with all community members. This includes Parent Conference Night April 5<sup>th</sup>, Breakfast with the Principal meetings monthly, Governance Council meetings monthly, and the Schoology online grading system through PASSport. Please see Ms. Brice, our Community Service Representative for more information about the aforementioned initiatives.
- February is our field trip month where all students will be going on various filed trips to enhance the concepts that are taught in the classrooms. It is expected that all students going on field trips are to wear their Mann UCLA Polo Shirts. If your child needs a new polo shirt, please purchase one from the Main Office.

Finally, February is Black History Month. This is a time to honor the contributions to America by many great African Americans of the past and today. As with Hispanic Heritage Month in September, we take these times to acknowledge that America would not be the great country it is without the significant contributions and sacrifices from people abroad.
