Teacher Library Cards

- Check out up to 50 items at a time for classroom use for 16 weeks.
- Books and audiobooks can be checked out for 16 weeks and music CDs and documentary DVDs for one week. Entertainment DVDs are loaned for 4 days.
- Teachers are responsible for fees incurred for lost or damaged items, and for overdue fines if materials are returned late.

Class Visits to the Library

- Library cards for students (parent's signature necessary)
- Tour of the library building.
- Introduction of library materials for homework help or pleasure reading.
- Storytelling, information literacy education, etc.
- Please schedule your visit two weeks in advance; you are welcome to come any time the library is open.

Librarian Visits to the Classroom

- Meant to get youth excited about books and the library.
- Invite students to visit the library with their families.
- Grab students' attention by bringing interesting new books and other media (Hoopla, e-books, etc.)

- Current, excellent reference materials in the branch and through our website's online resources/databases.

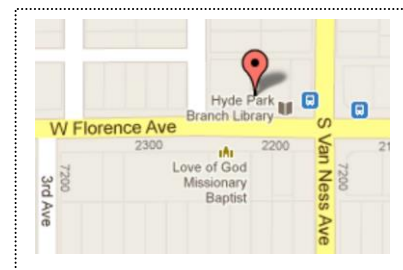
Assignment Alert!
