FamilySource Program offers free social, educational, work and family support services to low-income families who live in the City of Los Angeles.

## **Requirements :**

- Proof of income (dated within 90 days)
- Proof of residency (dated within 90 days)

## Services include, but are not limited to :

- Case management
- Parenting classes
- Financial literacy workshops
- Adult computer classes/lab
- Free tax preparation VITA
- Legal services (citizenship & right-to-work)
- Utility bill payment assistance (LIHEAP)
- Domestic violence services for victims/survivors
- Emergency supportive services such as: public transportation, diapers, & clothing (when available)
- Pre-employment assistance
- Public benefit application assistance (CalWorks, CalFresh, & Medi-Cal)

- Educational assessments with an LAUSD PSA Counselor
- Referrals to: child care, adult education, GED, ESL, vocational, job trainings
- Tutoring assistance (middle & high school students only)
- Mentoring for youth
- College corner activities (FAFSA, SAT, ACT, etc.) and college campus trips
- Civic engagement (selective service, voter registration, DMV DL/ID, or volunteer services
- And much more...
