



Become a U.S. Citizen!!!

YOU CAN BECOME A UNITED STATES CITIZEN IF:

- You have been a legal permanent resident for at least 5 years and:
 - Are 18 or older;
 - Have been present in the U.S. for at least 30 months out of the 5 years prior to your applying for citizenship;
 - Speak, read and write English;*
 - Have knowledge of U.S. History and Government;*
 - O Have good moral character; or
- You have been a legal permanent resident who is married to a U.S. Citizen for 3 years or more and:
 - Are 18 or older;
 - Have been living in marital union with the same U.S. citizen spouse during such time;
 - Speak, read and write English;*
 - Have knowledge of U.S. History and Government;*
 - o Have good moral character; or
- You have qualifying service in the U.S. armed forces.

If you already are a U.S. Citizen, your child may also qualify for naturalization if the child was born outside the U.S. and is currently residing outside the United States.
